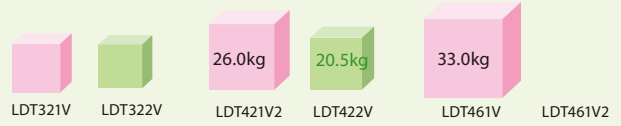

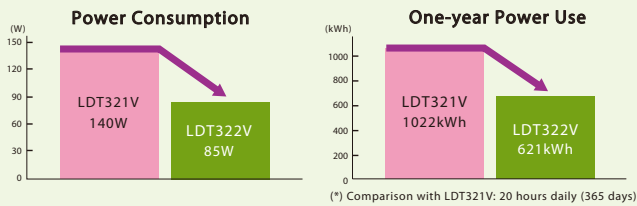




**Dark environment** (brightness reduced)      **Normal environment**      **Well-lit environment** (brightness increased)
